I was there yesterday. With no rain and limited irrigation times, it was very dry in a lot of areas. I know you realize this but I just wanted to make sure we are all on the same page. Below is what I saw. Mostly just dry but some potential/probable chinch bug areas that are noted and will receive a service call within 48 hours. Some tree and shrub issues as well. All areas will be monitored and checked again at the end of the week.

Entrance

- ✓ West side recovering dry area We installed larger nozzles 2 weeks ago coverage is good

Commons

Area in front of Jute and same side as Jute dry hot spots

- ✓ Circle in Plume coverage is good
- ✓ Dry area east end of Fossen near new construction potential chinch bug area Installed larger nozzles "good"
- ✓ Circle in Jute
- ✓ Dry/hot spots coverage is good

Hyperion

- ✓ 3403 - hotspots/dry areas, no signs of chinch bugs at time of report 1 - nozzle coverage is good
- ✓ 3415 - hotspots/dry areas, no signs of chinch bugs at time of report 2 - nozzles coverage is good
- ✓ 3423 - hotspots/dry areas, no signs of chinch bugs at time of report 2 - nozzles coverage is good
- ✓ 3474 - potential chinch bug area coverage is good
- 3473 - weeds

- ✓ 3482 Hyperion 1 - 12" popup spray head 2 - nozzles
- ✓ changed 1 spray head to a 12" spray head behind fountain
- changed 2 nozzles that were spraying on the porch
- ✓ 3508 Plume Dry spot rear - Right | coverage is good
- ✓ 3562 Kalista S-W corner head not working 1 - Roter head coverage good
- ✓ Replaced damaged spray head in the north culdesac "LeClair"
